

INFORMATION FOR WAKE COUNTY POLL WORKERS

Working the polls can be an effective way to influence voters, especially in this campaign. You may encounter folks who are unaware of the constitutional amendment.

To Help:

1. Vote Early (see early voting dates, times, and sites @ table below.)
2. On May 8th take the day off work and volunteer to work the polls. Volunteer for Early Vote too!
3. Decide how many days and how many shifts you can work. We will try to assign you to your own precinct. To learn your precinct # and polling place go to table below. You will need this to sign up. On May 8th shifts are: 6:30 - 9 am, 11 am - 1 pm, and 5 - 7 pm. Polls are open 6:30 am - 7:30 pm. You can work longer than a given shift. Early voting starts April 19 and the poll hours and locations vary. To sign up to work the polls in Wake County go to:

Instructions for Poll Workers:

1. Take a handmade sign to hold, preferably one that says "I'm Your Neighbor: Vote Against the Constitutional Amendment." **Key word is "Against"**. (We are not voting "no", we are voting "against." The constitutional amendment is the only amendment on the ballot. It will not say amendment one. It will say constitutional amendment.)
2. Smile. Be friendly. Do not engage in arguments with anyone.
3. Do not get closer than 50 ft to the entrance except in the special precincts where 25 ft is allowed.
