PLAYGROUND GUIDELINES

Unity (Unitarian Universalist)

Be aware of your connection to the environment and the people you share it with
 Take care of your environment the way that you would like to be taken care of
 Treat people the way you would like them to treat you

Friendship (Fellowship)

Be open to meeting new people and making new friends
 Include others
 Use Kind Words
 Share
 Take Turns
 Listen to the ideas of others

Order and safety (Of)

Walk when inside and when going through doorways
 Be gentle with equipment, each other and nature
 Only leave the playground with your parent or assigned guardian
 Practice remaining calm when working through problems together
 Ask playground monitors for help in using problem solving steps if needed *

Respect (Raleigh)

Listen to the playground monitors
 Pay attention to the needs and desires of your playmates
 Put playground equipment away when done
 Clean up after yourself
